



FIFPRO Asia/Oceania Team of the Tournament – Australia 2026

RULES OF ALLOCATION

The articles below relate to the “FIFPRO Asia/Oceania Team of the Tournament - Australia 2026”.

Art. 1. The “FIFPRO Asia/Oceania Team of the Tournament - Australia 2026” is comprised of the best 11 players at the AFC Women’s Asian Cup 2026, as voted by the participating players themselves.

Art. 2. To be eligible for receiving votes, players must have appeared in at least 1 match at the 2026 AFC Women’s Asian Cup.

Art. 3. All players selected in their respective national team final squad list are allowed to vote (once).

Art. 4. All votes count equally.

Art. 5. Each voting player nominates three different goalkeepers, three defenders, three midfielders and three forwards in no particular order.

Art. 6. Voting players may select a maximum of five players of the same nationality across their selections. Players are permitted to vote for their own teammates, subject to the nationality limit.

Art. 7. The players with the most votes in each position will be selected as follows:

- Maximum of one goalkeeper;
- Minimum of three defenders;
- Minimum of three midfielders;
- Minimum of three forwards;
- After the above has taken place, the outfield player with the highest number of votes (who has not already been selected) will be included in the FIFPRO Asia/Oceania Team of the Tournament as a fourth selectee in the relevant position.

Art. 8. Players’ positions will be based on the positions displayed on the respective national team profiles at the AFC’s dedicated Women’s Asian Cup web page.

Art. 9. Each voting player will be requested to make a valid vote submission via an online form provided by FIFPRO Asia/Oceania.

Art. 10. An independent expert panel composed of respected former and active players and leading journalists from across Asia has been appointed by FIFPRO Asia/Oceania to observe matches throughout the tournament and propose a positional shortlist based on on-field performance. The shortlist will act as an expert suggestion, with players able to vote for participating footballers not included on the shortlist.

Art. 11. In the event of a tie for the last available place(s) in a position (when the number of players exceeds the permitted number), the selection will be decided by the independent expert panel.

Art. 12. Any dispute arising from the voting process shall be reviewed and resolved by FIFPRO Asia/Oceania at its sole discretion. FIFPRO Asia/Oceania's decisions shall be final and binding.
